Minutes

After due notice to the public, Pendleton Town Council met at Pendleton Town Hall in Council Chambers. Mayor and all Council Members were present.

Mayor Burdette called the meeting to order.

1. Welcome To The New Town Council Members

Mayor Burdette introduced the new council members and gave background on both Denise Jackson and Bruce Kalley. She welcomed them to their new positions on Town Council.

2. Recognition To Town Council Members

Mayor Burdette thanked both James Allen and Leroy Galloway for their years of service with the Town Council. She presented them with a plaque as well. Both Mr. Allen and Mr. Galloway stated that they had enjoyed their time on Town Council and thanked the public and Mayor for their recognition.

3. Minutes of Prior Meetings

The minutes of prior meeting were read and approved. A correction was made to the minutes of June 6, 2005, page 3, paragraph 4, changing the spelling of AXE to ACTS. A correction was also made to the minutes of June 13, 2005, page 2, paragraph 5, changing the date from July 5, 2005 to August 1, 2005.

4. Public Comments

Mayor Burdette opened the floor for public comments. Ingrid Jackson spoke briefly about the parade of July 2, 2005. She thanked Council, Public Works and the Police Department for their assistance. Karen Meehan spoke about the property on S. Mechanic Street that had been rezoned. She indicated that it was her opinion that the process should be started from the beginning again because she felt that the sign placed on the property was not visible enough. Mayor Burdette advised that the property was posted according to the Town Ordinances' requirements.

5. Police Report – Chief Dyar

Chief Dyar was not in attendance. Mayor Burdette advised that Chief Dyar was working a shift and was not able to be at the meeting.

6. Playground Committee Update

Scott Ward updated Council and the public on the progress of the fundraising and also presented Council with a Barrett’s Place Sponsorship Pack. He went over the packet with Council and pointed out the different levels in which one could make a donation.

Mayor Burdette asked for a motion to add the Request for Approval of Final Plat from Heritage Place. Frank Crenshaw made a motion to add the request to the agenda. Bruce Kalley seconded. Vote unanimous.

Tom Wynnopp, representing Heritage Place, gave a brief update and explanation of the final plat.
